

Funding Application

The Blue Mountain Village Foundation is dedicated to awarding grants bi-annually to charitable organizations in the South Georgian Bay region whose activities support children, youth and family-oriented programs. The Foundation is committed to enhancing quality of life including the areas of health, education, the arts, the environment and recreation.

Support is given in the form of cash grants to provide funding for specific projects that meet the criteria of acceptance as outlined above. Operational costs or salaries will not be considered. Once the application review is complete, the Selection Committee will make recommendations to the Foundation's Board of Directors for final approval.

Application Deadlines:

October 1st (for Winter funding) April 1st (for Spring funding)

Due to the significant increase of applications over the past year, updated guidelines for submission have been developed in order to ensure a greater and realistic impact in our communities. The guidelines include the following:

- All eligible applicants (programs & initiatives) must reside in the following regions: Collingwood, Wasaga Beach, Stayner, Town of the Blue Mountains, Meaford, Duntroon, Singhampton, Kimberley and Creemore
- Projects must impact children, youth and families
- Financial request not to exceed \$5,000.00

In order to be eligible to receive a grant from the Blue Mountain Village Foundation the Applicant must meet the following criteria:

- Non-profit corporation with a charitable registration number
- Provide an on-going benefit to the communities surrounding the Blue Mountain Village
- Complete this application form and present a specific funding proposal to the Selection Committee
- On request, provide volunteers to support the Foundation event(s) that raises funds for the Applicant
- Prepare a follow-up report
